CARRIAGE CHATTER

Winter War Practice, January 25 – 27, Shire of Vogelburg

The Shire of Vogelburg held the first Winter War Practice of the Kingdom of Gleann Abhann organized by the Companions of the Sable Banner in preparation for Gulf Wars. The event was held the last weekend of January at the Kiwanis Camp in Tioga, Louisiana (near Pineville/Alexandria). Lord Motan was the autocrat and Lord Thomas Willoughby was the feastrat. Lady Ysolde of Mortwoode was in charge of reservations. Thirty-three fighters took the field to work on such things as Shield Wall Tactics, Spears and other Tactics used at WAR. A static display, open category Arts & Sciences contest was held. The rules were that the entry be “useful in war” and would be judged by the Sable Bannermen. While threats of snow and sleet prevented the Crown, Heirs, and Earl Marshal from attending, THL Caedmon of Jorvik, Secretary of the Sable Banner, reported that all present had a blast. Lord Michael atte Harp won the Arts & Sciences competition with a Norman helm. He also made beignets for everybody sometime after midnight Saturday. He also used a flashlight and fishbat to protect himself from the “mattress walls of doom” which entrapped THL Jean Louis Friday night.

Candlemas Collegium, February 2, Barony of Grey Niche

Lady Avice of York attended this annual one-day event in the Barony of Grey Niche. The theme this year was “A Day in the Life” and was for celebrating and teaching the arts and sciences that were practiced in the daily life of medieval cultures. The site opened at eight o’clock with classes beginning at nine o’clock. THL Cormac the Bald was the autocrat. Lady Marissa Symmes of Berewyk was the feastrat, preparing a sumptuous lunch consisting of stewed mutton, rice, fungus, hais, Icelandic chicken, green beans, glazed carrots, and Flaune of Almayne, which was held from noon to two o’clock. Viscountess Miriel organized the classes. Lady Avice taught two classes, one in the morning from eleven to noon on “Entering A&S – Tips from an Apprentice” and one in the afternoon from three to four o’clock on “Venison for Dummies”. The event was held in Cordova, Tennessee at the Heartsong Methodist Church.

Winter Wonders XXII, February 8-10, Shire of Ardanroe

The twenty-second Winter Wonders event was held the second weekend of February at Lake Bistineau State Park Group Camp One in Doyline, Louisiana. Despite being the height of flu season, 151 people including 18 children and 28 non-member adults attended the event. The theme was ‘Murder at the Faire’ and the setting was the 12th century during the English Civil War between those supporting King Stephen of England and those supporting Empress Matilda, daughter of King Henry I of England. Maistir Rory ua Riada was the autocrat and reservations, Lorccán na Túaithe the co-autocrat, while THL Dana the Quarrier was the feastrat. Lord James in le Breres was the gatekeeper while Lord Michael atte Harp oversaw troll. Lady Branwen was royal liaison, as Their Royal Highness’ William and Onora attended the event. Lord Johannes von Greiffenburg as site marshal oversaw three heavy weapons tournaments for the adults, while Baroness Bethany Bacon ran youth combat and Lady Ashikaga Shimofuri ran the rapier tourney. Sir Merwydd of Effington oversaw IKAC during the morning while Lady Rebecka MacGillivray oversaw children’s activities in the afternoon. Erde and Lorccán put out the SCA road signs. Lady Melisant monitored the loo. Lady Amata supplied RUGA information for the classes in the morning and afternoon.

Classes were well attended with people at Lord Ashikaga Hiromoto’s Drop Spinning Techniques, Lady Melisant of Exmoor’s Basic Naalbinding, THL Olaf Lutherson’s Introduction to Calligraphy, and THL Pol Uto’s Punching, Riveting, Drifting, Mortice, and Tenning. Mistress Sarah MacGregor oversaw the Persona A&S Triathlon while Lady Sabine le Curter oversaw the Miller’s Wife Mystery Game. A Tri-Page Tourney of three challenging activities was offered by Lorccán and his wife, Dianaim na Mhuimneach, but the teens present were too busy working the event to participate. Maybe next time!

Friday night’s Traveler’s Fare was done by Dana and included a roast, cheese, and bread. Saturday’s breakfast was done by Timo and included eggs, sausage, toast, and other goods. (There is a debate as to which one to get to do breakfast from now on – Timo or Erde) Lunch was hot sandwiches made by Dana, half of which were taken to the field for those watching and participating to eat, and the other half kept in the hall for those doing classes and other activities. Chips, fruit, and drink were also part of lunch. THL Celestine Albrit was the sole

merchant, while THL Anna Genevieve of Ancyra had a fundraiser table to raise money for the Gleann Abhann Trading Cards that appear at each Kingdom level event.

During the court of Their Royal Highness' William and Onora many were recognized for their prowess during the day with prizes, scrolls, and etched glasses. Mistress Sarah took her second associate, Bridget McGrannis. Master Robert von Flusswasser took his first associate during the tournaments, Beatrix de Montecassino. During feast the solver and solution to the Miller's Wife Mystery Game was revealed.

THL Olaf made the etched glasses used for the second time (new tradition) as prizes. Scrolls were done by Rory and Melisant. Other prizes of books, swords, and leather pouch were donated by members of the Shire. Lady Ceara Ó Bárdáin was the Prize Coordinator. The last four etched glasses were given to TRH William and Onora and Duke Ulsted and Countess Ebegardis as gifts during feast. Baron Grimbaldus Bacon was the Hall Steward for feast. This year a table sign-up poster was used for everyone attending feast to pick the tables they would sit at. (Next year we will put table-top numbers on the tables themselves to help with this.) Rory took this idea from the Barony of Iron Mountain. A menu with ingredients was provided for each table by Lady Ceara. The Feast of the Winter Faire featured the cooks of Ardanroe with eight cooks providing dishes for the three and a half courses. The diners entered the hall to find bread, butter, and cheese on each table along with tablecloths. Lentil soup (James and Sarah), meat pies (Ceara), and bacon-wrapped dates (Dana) formed the first course. Venison and winter vegetables (Avice) formed the second course. Pork loin and macaroni and cheese (Erde and Heylen Tabita) formed the third course. Petit fours (Michael) formed the half course at closing. Entertainment was coordinated by Heylen and featured her fabulous sword dancing and songs by Lord Bran Finan O'Niall and Lady Melisande of Loch Bais. After feast, food and drink were placed on a table on the hall's porch for all to partake, while the diners encouraged the evening by campfires.

Gleann Abhann Fighter Collegium & War Practice, February 22-24, Shire of Loch Bais

Blaec, Erde, Medb, Rory, and Sarah represented the Shire of Ardanroe at the Kingdom of Gleann Abhann Fighter Collegium and War Practice the weekend of February 22-24, 2008 hosted by the Shire of Loch Bais at the Caney Conference Center in Minden, Louisiana. All five appear to have attended for the day, some departing after court and before feast. Blaec and Erde armored up. Blaec was also entourage to TRHs William and Onora and part of TRHs court guards, bearing a spear behind the throne that evening. Medb and Rory socialized with many who had not been able to attend Winter Wonders due to the flu or work schedules. Sarah did Kingdom work. Lord Finian O'Niall was autocrat; Lord Ian O'Donnell reservations; and Lady Marcella le Despencer feastcrat. The event drew

119 people. The Gleann Abhann Trading Cards at this Kingdom level event were: Elesar of Northumbria and Havordh Aettarbani.

For the heavy fighters there was war practice in the morning along with combat archery authorizations. The afternoon was fight-a-knight with individual training, more one-on-one than group tactics. Rapier activities occurred in the morning and afternoon. Vicomtesse Miriel du Bois held Live Weapons MIT Training in the morning. THL Ambrielle Llewellyn, Emerald Herald, held the Basics of Running a List in the afternoon. Baroness Bethany Bacon offered Youth Combat classes. Mistress Brigit, Kingdom Chirurgeon, held four classes during the day – So you want to be a Chirurgeon; Chirurgeon 103: Armor Extraction and Field Etiquette; Chirurgeon 101: Roles and Responsibilities; Chirurgeon 102: Medical/Trauma Emergencies. Lady Yliria held childrens activities which included the Great Frisbee Challenge, Marshmallow archery (aka Defend the Flock), knight bowling, mask making, stained glass coloring, clay time, necklace making, and assorted outdoor games.

A silent auction, WWP t-shirts, and fundraiser lunch of chili and cornbread were held by Duchess Mary Grace and Lord Charles de Bourbon for the Royal Reception at Gulf Wars. They were successful in raising the amount desired. Fifteen Kingdoms will be represented at Gulf Wars this year. Lady Rebecka MacGillivray sold bandanas to support our Lady Ceara. The funds are now going to assist with her medical bills. Queen Kenna received assistance from several ladies during the day in the hemming and appliqué work to finish the Crown's Opening Ceremonies outfits for Gulf Wars (which will be worn when riding the horses in the opening procession).

During court many friends from neighboring Shires were recognized by the Crown. Sir Elesar of Northumbria presented a gift of two Collars of Estate Shires for the Crowns to wear made by his own hands. King Uther rallied everyone for Gulf Wars. Trimaris will be our ally and Ansteorra our foe. Baroness Isabella D'Arques was named as the new Emerald Herald, replacing Ambrielle at the conclusion of her term (that day). Lord Ravenswar Brachae was named the Replacement Deputy Seneschal to the Kingdom Seneschal by Master Erik of Telemark. Ravenswar will become Kingdom Seneschal one year from now. Sir Uric is raffling a sheath and combat seax at Gulf Wars for the Discretionary Fund. Time of the Bob Party was given and a call for volunteers needed for many areas at Gulf Wars.

Sadie of Troll Fen won the chocolate M&Ms from Baroness Barbara, though not from a guessing game but from sitting in the chair during court that had the winning note attached underneath it. His Majesty won M&Ms also, which bode ill in the cycle of previous reigns (foreshadowing).

Feast was delicious and included Boursin cheese spread and regular butter for plain and wheat bread, olives a la Marcilla, lentil pottage, chipotle crusted roast pork, Spätzle, roast sweet potatoes, Balsamic orange glazed chicken, rice-pea pilaf, and apple tarts and cookies.



FORTNIGHT

The Shire Populace Meeting was held on Wednesday, February 13, 2008 at the Aulds Branch Library in Bossier City. The meeting started at 7:00 and ended around 9:00 p.m. Sarah, as Seneschal, ran the meeting. Thirteen adults (Sarah, Dana, Medb, Olaf, Melisant, Rory, Amata, Avice, Michael, Ceara, Ibrahim, Hesper, and Timo) and three children (Eric, Elizabeth, and Alexi) attended the meeting.

The upcoming events in February and March occurring in Gleann Abhann were gone over by Sarah. New officers were introduced. Rory is now the herald and Ceara the minister of arts and sciences. Files will be given to each at a later date. Winter Wonders was a resounding success. Sarah would like to create an Event Handbook for the Shire which gives basic job descriptions for each staff member. It should streamline the “who does what when and where” part of the event. Input is desired from everyone.

Medb as Reeve reported that the 2007 Doomsday Report for the Shire was done. The Shire had a loss of roughly \$575, which is from upkeep for the trailer and purchase of a new pavilion.

Ceara as incoming Minister of Arts and Sciences asked that everyone email their activities to her for compiling the quarterly reports.

Rory as incoming Herald would like to update the Shire's Order of Precedence which appears on the Shire Herald's web page. Everyone is encouraged to send in updates, correction, etc. as the Shire's OP is current as of May 2007. Sarah will generate a new one from the Kingdom's online OP to work from that is more up-to-date. Everything submitted by Shire members for names and armory from September to December have now been processed at Kingdom and went out in the January 2008 Gleann Abhann Letter of Intent, except Branwen's device, which was presumably returned.

Johannes was not present so there was not a Knight Marshall report.

Olaf as the new Constable will be doing the event report for Winter Wonders. Rory gave him paperwork at the meeting.

Amata as Provost reported that many classes were held and were well attended at Winter Wonders. RUGA class evaluations were done and summarized. A report will be sent to the RUGA Chancellor.

Rory as Chronicler reported that the February issue of Ardanrunes is online. A copy was given to the Historian and Seneschal. Articles and such are needed from the populace. An electronic reminder message has been set up on the Ardanroe yahoo group for this year.

Ceara as Historian had nothing to report. The Prince's persona story was in the February issue.

Michael as Chatelaine had nothing to report. Sarah reported that the Scottish Society has contacted them about a demo at the Highland Games in Minden the second weekend of April. This conflicts with Spring Coronation and a mundane wedding. Avic is looking into the details for this demo and will get back to the group.

Sarah is still currently the de facto Quartermaster but wants to find someone to oversee this position and store the Shire's property. A discussion was held regarding the amount of equipment and whether a storage unit should be rented. Melisant and Olaf offered a shed at their place, which currently needs new doors.

Lorccan was not present so there was no Webminister report.

Rory and Dana gave the Winter Wonders XXII report and recap. The sign-up for a table for feast was liked by the populace, but next time in addition to having labeled the tables on the sign-up poster the tables themselves need to be labeled. The fighters had a great day fighting and the weather was wonderful. The Heirs of Gleann Abhann attended Winter Wonders and had a good time. Final attendance figures were reported as was the estimated profit. Several people turned in receipts for reimbursement at the meeting but several still need to. Sarah's washing machine ate her soup receipt and she is calling it a donation. Everyone was thanked. Rory distributed thank you gifts.

Bids are now being accepted for next year's Winter Wonders. Sarah plans to submit a bid. Therefore bids are to be sent to Medb, the Exchequer, instead of to the Seneschal. Medb will oversee the discussion and selection of the bid for Winter Wonders XXIII in January 2009 (exact date to be announced next month once park reserved).

The Kingdom needs bids for events. Sarah would like the books closed on this year's Winter Wonders before discussing bids for any Kingdom events this year.

The meeting was adjourned.

It is time to update the Shire of Ardanroe's Heraldic records. This month the Shire Ardanroe Order of Precedence is being looked at. The following list of awards, names, dates, and Kingdoms/Principalities is from the Kingdom of Gleann Abhann's Online Order of Precedence (OOP) as of October 4, 2007.
