Jacqueline was the very first Kingdom Minister of Children for Meridies serving from January 1992 to April 1993. Isabeau gave up the position to devote more time to the local office of Minister of Arts and Sciences. While there have been children's activities at Shire events, the position of Shire Minister of Children has been vacant, and effectively abolished, since Elspeth resigned.



'FEAST GEAR WAR' AT NOVEMBER FAIRE

Garb War was the fabulous competition held at Fighter Collegium in October. This month at November Faire (November 11th) will be "Feast gear War". Below is the information from Queen Mary Grace about this exciting contest and fundraiser.

In order to raise money for the Royal Travel Fund, feast gear will be auctioned off. To make it even more fun, the feast gear will be judged as a competition to show your creative side.

Put together a feast sets for two with a unique theme. Your basket can be inspired by a place or by color themes or a certain type of feast just to name a few ideas. Use your imagination! The feast gear set should include all the basics (plates, bowls, silverware, napkins, and candles) including a basket or box or bag for the set to go in and points will be awarded for additional creativity. The entrant that has the basket judged to be the best will have they opportunity to choose from all the baskets for one that they can keep. The remaining baskets will be auctioned off with the funds to benefit the Royal Travel Fund. You can enter more than one feast set in the competition/auction!



LET'S DANCE!

This month's dance is: Korobushka

The Korobushka is the Russian dance of love (okay, we are being rather liberal here). It is winter and cold and you want to dance with the girl. This is a couple's dance. The couples form a line and then make a circle. The men are on the left (thereby inside the circle) and the ladies are on the right (thereby outside the circle). The lord and lady forming the couple join hands together. There is no exchange of partners. There is no linking up of dancers. There is simply each couple dancing the dance with all of the couples lined up to form a circle. Instead of starting with the left foot, the dancers start with their right foot.

Slowly with the music the dancers step out with their right foot and join with their left. Again step out with their right foot and join with their left. They then do the same with their left foot – step out and join with right twice. They step out with their right foot and join with left once. They step out with their left foot and join with their right once. The Lord lifts his right arm so that the couple faces each other – the Lord facing out and the Lady facing in. The couple drops their hands – releasing their hands. Then to the count of four the Lady spins out of the circle and the Lord spins in to the circle. They both clap their hands. They then spin back together to the count of four and again clap their hands. Taking each others right hand, they step together and step apart. The Lady then walks under the Lord's arm so that they have switched places. They release their hands and once again spin to the count of four and clap, and return spinning to the count of four and clap. So here the Lord has spun out of the circle and the Lady has spun in to the circle. Again they take their right hands, step together and apart. The Lady walks in front of the Lord to assume their original position. And the dance starts all over again.

With this dance the music starts out slow and will gradually increase in speed. At the very end of the dance the Lord will usually go down on one knee and the Lady will sit on his raised knee/leg.

Gleann Abhann Fighter Collegium, October 6-8

The last fall Kingdom of Gleann Abhann Fighter Collegium was held the first weekend of October at the Kiwanis Club of Alexandria's Camp in Pineville, Louisiana by the Shire of Vogelburg. Heavy weapons, light weapons (rapier), youth combat, and archery were the activities composing the fighter collegium portion of the event on the 7th. The first ever Garb Wars competition in Gleann Abhann sponsored by Queen Mary Grace also occurred, all garments being made during the event and judged in a Fashion Show during Feast. Two teams competed – Team M&M and Team I Flew in from Atenveldt and All I Got was this Zupan. Kassimir (formerly known as Robert of Ardanroe from the 1990's) flew in from Atenveldt to be the model for the Polish coat made to go over his armor and a spiffy Polish hat. The seamstresses Sara de la Petra, Beatrix de Montague (Team Captain), and Nonie Wlfraven did an excellent job and this team won the Garb War and received a gift card for sewing supplies. Team M&M as second place winner also received a gift card for their entry, a 12th century bliaunt. Martha Effingham of Stewart's Kepe was the M&M team captain. As with all of the Kingdom level events, the collectors' cards were distributed at troll. Grey Niche was the second Barony to be featured in the "Gleann Abhann Group Series" while Stephen Wolfe, a Knight and Duke, joined the "Gleann Abhann Peer Series". Lord James en les Breres and Lady Nonie Wlfraven were spearheading combat target archery in the hopes of developing a Combat Yeoman. The competition for this honor would involve wearing armor as a combat archer and firing at a target from positions found in battle – behind a shield line, timed, etc. and from varying distances similar to those in regular target archery – ten yards, fifteen yards, etc. Targets and 'shields' were built at James' and brought to the event to test out under the watchful eye of Sayyid Saad. The weather was beautiful, sunny but with a breeze. The ground was dry. The temperature had a low during the evenings near fifty degrees and highs during the day near eighty degrees. It was perfect or near perfect weather for an outdoor event. Eric and baby Elizabeth, Olaf Lutherson and Melisant of Exmoor's children, were under the watchful eye of another so that mother and father could fight on the field. Even Viscountess Christine O'Neill of Cork came with her newly adopted twenty month old daughter from China, Teagan Kathleen Nian Spillane. Others from Ardanroe attending collegium classes included Maximilian, Alexander, Blaec, Lorccan, Johannes, and Gary(?). A vigil for Rory to contemplate the path of the Pelican was overseen by Sarah with Medb in charge of the reception. Food was provided by many including Medb, Dana, Michael, Ceara, Rovena, Conor (Boogie), and James. Sir Elazar and Viscountess Marion loaned their pavilion for the reception while Tegan, Magdalena, Avice, Gida, Kat, Ariadne, and Mistress Jane also brought food. Vigil chairs were provided by Johannes and Dana (all made by Johannes) while the tent was Medb's. Rory's vigil garb was made by Sarah and James along with armbands for the vigil guards and a standard for the new Pelican of Gleann Abhann (the first Peerage elevation in the new Kingdom). Adrienne was the vigil door monitor while many good gentles served as guards. During the late afternoon court Blaec received the Combattant Ram. He was escorted by Viscountess Rainillt! Rory's elevation ceremony was filled with challenges. Master Erik spoke as his sponsor and Peer. Sir Loric was the Knight

Challenger, Mistress Brigit the Laurel Challenger, Mistress Daphne the Pelican Challenger, and Viscount Elazar the Royal Challenger. THL Sarah represented the populace in speaking on his behalf. Rory's elevation garb was made by Lady Branwen Ballard. The Pelican cloak was made by Mistress Daphne and Mistress Diana. The Pelican medallion was made by Sir Loric. The cap of maintenance was made by THL Celestine. The Peerage scroll was done by Viscountess Marion. And the big surprise gift, the baronial coronet with the Pelican badge, was made by Baroness Etheldred "Dredda". Sadly Master Sinclair and Mistress Evelyn were not able to attend but they were there in spirit well represented by their former associates Mistress Jennet, Mistress Daphne, and Countess Meaghan. Masque of the Red Death, October 20-22

Held the third weekend of October at Jimmie Davis State Park in Chatham, Louisiana, the Shire of Blackwood’s Masque of the Red Death was a major social function of the fall. During the morning the Wheel of Death Tournament was held. Twenty-two fighters participated as entrants or marshals in this annual tourney which mixed skill of arms with the fate of the wheel. Maximilian von Braun, James en les Breres, Johannes von Gruefenburg, Olaf Lutherson, and Melisant of Exmoor represented Ardanroe on the field. James also taught “Geography of the Plague” after lunch. Aline Lucas and Arthur from “north Ardanroe” attended their first Gleann Abhann event since coming from Caid. Aline and Rebekah MacGillivray did the children’s activities. Many Ardanroe youths were present including Eric, baby Elizabeth, and Aline and Arthur’s son and two daughters. A new game “Autograph Bingo” was held in the morning while “Bocce” teams competed in the afternoon. During the Crown’s court Grimboldus Bacon and Bethany Bacon of the Shire of Loch Bais received Court Baronies. After feast Hugh du Lac and Branwen Ballard ‘captured’ THL Motan and showed their artistic skills in the Captured Celt Coloring Contest. TOWN FAIRE

Ten adults and two children attended the September 27th A&S glass etching workshop at the Aulds Library. Forty-eight plates (24 big and 24 small) were decorated using glass etching techniques. The two primary charges of the group were used - the big ones have a circle of fleur-de-lis and the small ones have the Shire's castle.

Four members attended the Shire's first Wednesday of the month extra A&S workshop October 4th at James' to make the combat archery targets. Much of the work had been done beforehand by James and Max but there was still painting and nuts and bolts to add Wednesday.

Fighter practice was held at Mike Woods Park on October 1st and was small. Three people armored up at 9:00 a.m. with three others arriving late to cheer them on. Fighter practice for the 15th was cancelled due to pending weather and the Shire activities on the 14th. Practice on the 29th was cancelled due to the rain Wednesday and Thursday.

Nine adults and three teens attended the October 14th extra fighter practice, beer-making class, and social at Johannes and Branwen's, which began at one o'clock and lasted until just after nine o'clock. The teens viewed period and non-period movies while Johannes taught the adults how to make beer and the differences between ale and lager and flavorings of the beer with hops and fruits. Other projects were worked on during the early afternoon. Lorccan showed off his new pickle barrel armor. Tacos and cheese enchiladas were the main staple of the "Mexican" feast.

A Winter Wonders planning meeting was held at six o'clock at Aulds Library on the 25th of October before the start of the monthly A&S workshop at seven o'clock. Five people attended the event planning meeting. The Kingdom Map tapestry was begun as the A&S workshop on canvas James had already applied gesso to. This project was outlined as to the things to do to create the map and decision made to use the arms of the groups in the border and to use towers/castles with the names of the groups inside the map itself. Seven people attended the workshop.

FORTNIGHT



The October Populace Meeting was held on the 11th at Aulds Branch Library on Wayne Drive in the Shady Grove subdivision in Bossier City. Ten people (Sarah, Dana, Medb, Rory, James, Johannes, Branwen, Amata, Tad, and John Goddard) attended. Sarah, as Shire Seneschal, ran the meeting. The calendar of upcoming events was announced and dates and times of fighter practices given. The fall 2006 Shire Census Phone Book was distributed. It will be available in print form only. As Quartermaster Sarah is working on the inventory and would like a list from each officer of inventory items they have for their office. Johannes reported as Deputy Knight Marshal that fighter practice on the 1st was nice and reminded all that there would be a fighter practice on the 14th at his house in the afternoon. He has not heard from Max as to whether fighter practice will still occur on the 15th. Dana as Constable has filed the monthly report on signed waivers from Shire activities (fighter practices). The web minister and historian were not present. Branwen as Deputy Chatelaine reported that Michael was working so unable to attend tonight's meeting and that Mr. Goddard would give a presentation on a possible demo/joint venture with the Gilbert and Sullivan Society later in the meeting. James reported that the Herald's report had been filed and Lorccan is working on his name and device. James as Minister of Arts and Sciences reported that he will be working with Tad to prepare the Kingdom Map tapestry project for layout/drawing at the A&S

workshop on the 25th. Every night after it is begun members will be encouraged to help work on it at James' to have it ready for November Faire on the 11th. Rory reported that the October issue of Ardanrunes was on the website and turned in a print copy to the Seneschal. Ceara has printed out a copy of each issue for the Historian's office. Amata will see James about setting up classes for Winter Wonders.

Under Old Business Sarah reminded everyone to see James about evenings for extra credit A&S. James is looking for a date to hold a meeting on Winter Wonders. It was decided to hold the meeting at 5:30 on the 25th before the A&S workshop starts. Several members attended Charmaine's father's funeral in September and Sarah sent a plant on behalf of the Shire.

Under New Business Mr. John Goddard presented the Madrigal Dinner idea he is researching for the Gilbert and Sullivan Society. He would like to hold one or more dinners the first week of January. The Shire may be able to help with costuming, dances, and props. Depending on location the Shire might be able to help with the food. More information is needed but there is a definite interest to continue the relationship between the Gilbert & Sullivan Society and the SCA Shire of Ardanroe. Mr. Goddard will check on locations next and report back on his findings.

Everyone was reminded about the feast gear contest/fundraiser auction at November Faire and that James is willing to take entries for the Faire to the event with him. Dana distributed copies of a class handout she picked up from Fighter Collegium, though it was not taught there. The class handout was "Courtly Manners: The Basics of Precedence and Protocol – Titles, addresses and what Court is all about in the SCA" by Mary Grace of Gatland, which was taught at Harvest Home September 30th.
